

ORDINANCE NO. G-86-1019

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SNOW REMOVAL
FROM SIDEWALKS ON THE CITY RIGHTAWAY

WHEREAS, The City of Woodburn is embarking on a City wide Sidewalk improvement program,

WHEREAS, maintenance of sidewalks is the responsibility of the property owner,

WHEREAS, the majority of property owners who have sidewalks have not cleared their sidewalks of snow thusfar this 1985-1986 winter season, and

WHEREAS, the lack of snow removal from the sidewalks constitutes a hazard for the public either using the sidewalks or forced to walk in the streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURN, INDIANA, that:

1. Snow accumulation will be removed from the sidewalks located on City rightaway (sidewalks parallel to the streets) within 12 hours following the end of a snowfall.
2. This ordinance shall be in full force and affect from and after adoption hereof and approval by the Mayor.
