Minutes for the Woodburn City Council Meeting on May 6th, 2024:

The meeting began at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance was Mayor Kelsey, Clerk-Treasurer Hileman, Superintendent Walls as well as Council Members Graber, Gerig, Gentz, Sarrazine, and Watts.

The dumpster at the apartment complex was discussed, there have been residents that complained about the living conditions in the apartments, Council Member Sarrazine will follow up.  
Council Member Sarrazine brought forward discussions of dogs running free around town. The Mayor will follow up.

Bernie from Homeland Security was present to discuss Allen County emergency OP plan.  
The city is required to have their own plan or adopt Allen County's plan. Multi Hazard mitigation plan was also discussed. This needs to be renewed every 5 years with Federal money available only if the plan is in place.  
Herb Anderson was present to discuss New Allen Alliance. Grant applications were also discussed.
