Minutes for the Woodburn City Council Meeting on June 17th, 2024:

The meeting began at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance was Mayor Kelsey, Clerk-Treasurer Hileman, Superintendent Walls, as well as Council Members Graber, Gentz, Gerig, Sarrazine and Watts.

Chief's Report:

Not present.

Superintendent's Report:

Superintendent Walls informed the Council that on Roemer Drive, the trucks had been driving off the sides of the road and Stone was added.

Mayor's Report:

Mayor Kelsey informed the Council that the State would be paving State Road 101 in 2025. The Mayor also mentioned with the City's growth, the city may need to consider an additional Officer and Utility worker in the 2025/2026 budget.

Clerk-Treasurer's Report:

The meeting minutes were presented from the June 3rd meeting. After discussion, Council Member Gerig moved to accept the meeting minutes as presented, second by Council Member Sarrazine. All others present in favor. The warrants were presented. After discussion, Council Member Sarrazine moved to pay the warrants as presented, second by Council Member Graber, all present in favor.
